





# **International Online Chess Tournament** between the Moscow City and foreign cities teams

## 1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. The promotion of sport exchanges between the cities.
- 1.2. The promotion and popularization of chess.
- 1.3. The implementation of Internet technologies in sports events.
- 1.4. The challenge for the best teams in online blitz competitions.
- 1.5. The promotion of a healthy lifestyle.

#### 2. DATES AND LOCATIONS

- 2.1. Dates: December 2020

#### 3. ORGANIZERS

- 3.1. The Moscow Sport Department (<a href="https://mos.ru/moskomsport/">https://moscowchess.org/</a>) and the Chess Federation of Moscow (<a href="https://moscowchess.org/">https://moscowchess.org/</a>).
- 3.2. The responsibilities of the organizers are as follows:
- the development of site layouts, **mskchess.ru** branding and online broadcasts;
- the staging of the tournament, its organization and technical support;
- the registration of all participants' accounts (30 accounts);
- the technical support of all participants (30 persons);
- the technical support of online broadcasting;
- the starting order, timing and cheating control and support;
- the creation of a database of all games played by each participant and further instructions for analysis (30 persons).

## 4. PARTICIPATION TERMS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1. City teams of 15 persons (max 30 persons) are invited to participate.
- 4.2. The age limits: boys and girls born in 2002 2012.
- 4.3. Students of chess schools and clubs are especially welcome.
- 4.4. The choice of locations is free for all participants (e.g. home, office, sport schools, sport clubs, etc.).
- 4.5. A laptop and Internet access are mandatory (100 MB/s +).
- 4.6. The participation in our online tournament is free of charge.
- 4.7. Preliminary entries via https://mskchess.ru/ are mandatory.

### 5. GENERAL

5.1. The competition are to be in the **blitz** format using the **lichess** system at **www.mskchess.ru**.

Time control: 5 min. for the entire game + 3 sec. per move, starting from the first one, per each participant. Each player will get 2 points for winning a game and 1 point for a draw. If a participant wins several consecutive games his/her points are to be doubled (so-called 'series'). The winner is to be the team with the highest number of points. If a participant plays

a game in a draw, then in the next game, if it also ends in a draw, he/she must make at least 30 moves in order to get 1 point, or otherwise he/she will get 0 points for the game.

- 5.2. Commentators: Russian and English.
- 5.3. The duration of the online tournament is 1,5 hrs.

## 6. SAFETY OF PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS

6.1. The competitions are to be held online. All participants are to ensure their own safety at their respective locations.

## 7. TOURNAMENT RANKINGS AND AWARDS

- 7.1. The results in the team event are to be determined by the total number of points scored. There is also a personal ranking.
- 7.2. The Prize Winners and runners-up are to be awarded with electronic certificates of participation.

The rules and regulations of the tournament are to be agreed between the parties.
